

ADMISSION OF PUPILS TO SCHOOL

Hampshire's Admissions Policy takes account of all relevant legislation including the Education Act 2002.

Admissions Policies for both the Nursery Unit and the Infant School are available on the school website.

Our school caters for children from the age of 3 in our Nursery Unit.



Children can begin the Infant School from the September following their 4th birthday. We admit up to 60 pupils per year.

Children transfer to a Junior school, usually Peel Common Junior School at the beginning of the September that follows their 7th birthday. Families need to apply for a place at the Junior school when their children are in Year 2. The children make several visits there and they move confidently to this new stage of their education.

STARTING SCHOOL

The pattern of attendance in the Autumn term depends partly on parents' preferences and partly on information gathered during the transition activities.

All children will attend part time in the induction week in September.

NON-RECEPTION AGE CHILDREN

Application for places for older children and for new arrivals in the school's catchment area may be made at any time. Where there is space, places will be allocated according to the school's admissions policy.

WAITING LIST

If you are unable to be given a school place immediately you may be placed on the waiting list.

You may contact the school at any time to find your position on the list. We will contact you as soon as a place comes available for your child.

APPEALS

If you remain unsuccessful, but still wish to secure a placement for your child, then you have the right to appeal to an Independent Appeals Panel. The school office will explain this procedure to you.
